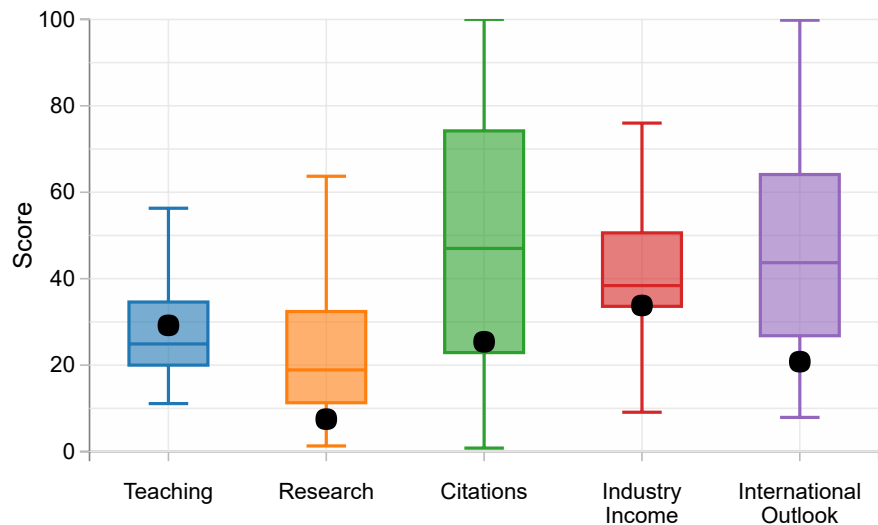
Your performance in the 2018 Times Higher Education World University Ranking
